





A safe place to store a medicine



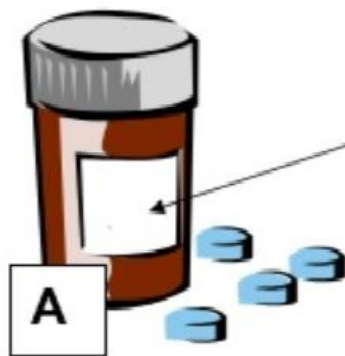
A dangerous place to store a medicine
